- Bring ID and proof of income when going for the first time; you will need to complete a registration during the first visit

Halton Fresh Food Box (an affordable way to buy fruit and vegetables)

- May not be running yet due to COVID-19

- Seasonal fruit and vegetables
- Ordered once a month and delivered to a local site for pick up on the 4th Tuesday of the month
- \$22 for large box, \$17 for small box or \$12 for single bag (pay at pick up or online when ordering)
- If you are on Ontario Works, ODSP, Children's Services or Prenatal Services- contact your support worker to find out if you are eligible to receive a box.
- Pick up on the 4th Tuesday of the month ordered at:
 - St. George's Anglican Church – 60 Guelph St. Georgetown
 - St. Andrew's Church – 89 Mountainview Rd. South, Georgetown
