- Bring ID and proof of income when going for the first time; you will need to complete a registration during the first visit

Fresh Food Box for Halton *Run by Kerr St Mission* (an affordable way to buy fruit and vegetables)

- Seasonal fruit and vegetables ordered once a month and delivered to a local site for pick up
- \$20 for large box, \$10 for small box (pay online when ordering or) Must be paid in full by the 18th of the month for
- Ordering occurs from the 1st of the month until the 18th of the month for the next month's pick up. Pickups are the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month
- You can place orders and pick up boxes at Acton Links2Care (Contact Cathy at 519-853-3310 or cgarrow@links2care.ca)
- If you are on Ontario Works, ODSP, Children's Services or Prenatal Services contact your support worker to find out if you are eligible to receive a box. - Pick up on the 4th Tuesday of the month from Links2Care, 47 Mill St., Acton
